### Ephrata Fair –

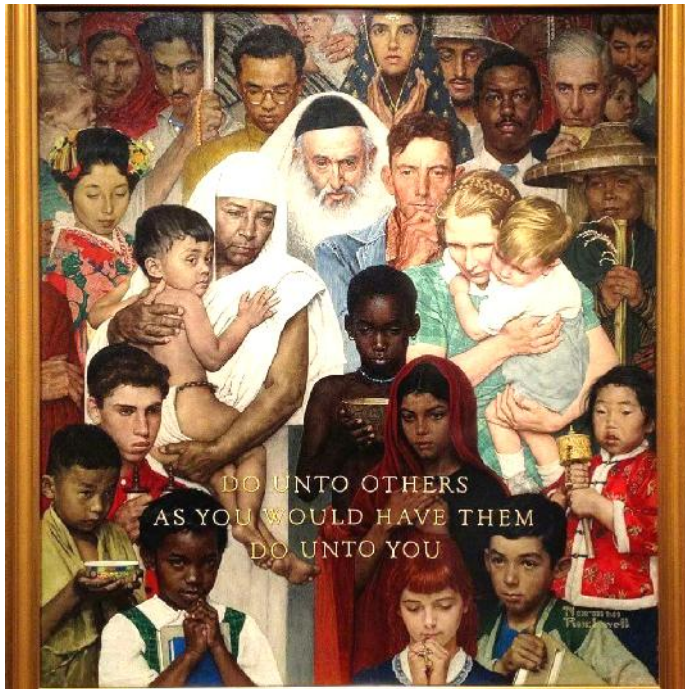
