Looking forward to another great year of being a Lion and working with all of you.

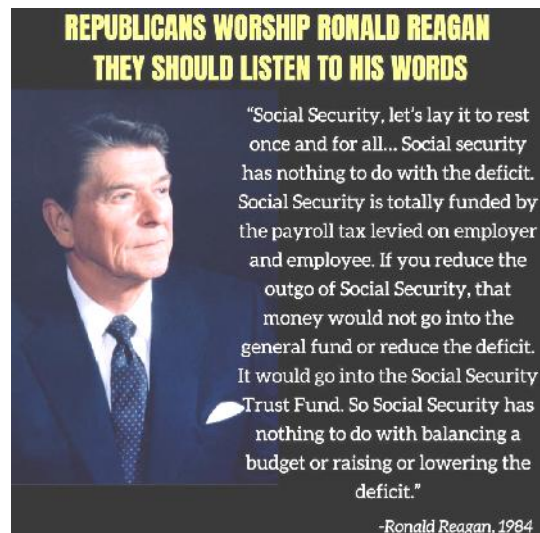
From Lion President Timothy: Lions all,
