In the Right Place at the Right Time

I'm sure you heard the saying, "In the Right Place at the Right Time" and you probably experienced it at one time. Well, I and the East Cocalico Lions recently was "In the Right Place at the Right Time".

We were contacted the other week by Tammy Frey a nurse in the Cocalico School District. The School District was trying to determine a way to perform vision screening on their students this school year considering the pandemic and mitigation protocols. The scanner and methods they used previously could not be used because of Covid-19 safety issues. The School District found a vision screening device that could be purchased that would permit sight screening, but it was quite expensive, at approx. \$8000. This device can also be used to screen their special needs students in the future, since they are often not able to perform this function due to their limited cognitive or physical limitations.

Knowing that vision is one of the club's values, Tammy was reaching out to the club wondering if we could assist them in any way to help purchase this scanner. Unfortunately, because of our current treasury I knew it would be difficult to make any meaningful donation toward this piece of equipment even if we went to the other local clubs in the School District. They are in the same situation we are.

Then I came up with the Solution!

The Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Service Foundation, which I am a member of the Board of Directors, was created for a situation like this. The Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Service Foundation (NEPALSF), formerly known as Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Eye Bank, was created with the primary goal of eliminating corneal blindness. One of the services they provide is providing Club Sponsored "Grants" to individuals and organizations for Patient Care, Equipment, Professional Education and Community Projects. Most of these Grants are provided without a cost to the club.

Since they needed this scanner as soon as possible, I asked Lion President Dennis if I could Email the East Cocalico Lions Board of Directors and get their permission to go ahead and apply for a Grant. The Directors all voted "Yes" to go ahead and apply for this Grant. I completed the paperwork needed for a Grant and sent it to the Grant Committee of the Foundation.

We were approved for the Grant in no time and will be receiving a Check for the Cost of this scanner in about a week and then I will present the check to Tammy.

Being able to get the Funds needed, even during these times when Finances are low, is just another way that the East Cocalico Lions were in the "Right Place at the Right Time" and were still able to "Serve".
