SECRETARY REPORT

 - Rent or bring your own goats Lion Marie know someone who can help arrange)

- Drive Thru Fish Fry – Every Friday night @ Silo
 - Fish Sandwiches, French Fries and Slaw only for \$10

- Lion Jamie Carpenter made motion, Seconded by Lion Ray Kunkel to pursue the Fish Fry every Friday. Board Approved motion. Lion Tim will help coordinate but will need help of 6-7 Lions every Friday night from Approx. 4-7 pm (Preferable different Lions every week, there are enough of us to rotate). We will contact Lion Don Hartranft for advertising on Facebook. Will plan to start in October.
- **FOOD DRIVES** - EASS is in need of Food so we need to continue our Food Drives:
 - Will have mini Food Drive at Ebenezer's Saturday September 12
 - Will have mini Food Drive at Redner's and Ebenezer's September 26

 - Will plan to have big food drive for EASS in October 24th & 25th

This will also help Lion Carl with holiday gifts as people will be able to see what has been given and what is left.
